Register your farm with ISDH

All farms covered by the Produce Safety Rule are required to register with the Indiana State Department of Health. Registration forms can be found at in.gov/isdh/25773.htm



Complete a PSA training course

One person from your farm must attend a PSA grower training to learn the requirements of the Produce Safety Rule. These are held periodically in different locations around the state. Visit safeproducein.com for training dates and locations.
